Declaring September 8, 2022 "Roots of Peace Day" in Yountville, California

WHEREAS, Roots of Peace is a humanitarian non-profit organization founded in September 1997 by San Francisco Bay Area residents Heidi and Gary Kuhn to fulfill their vision to transform "Mines to Vines" by replacing minefields with sustainable agricultural farmlands around the world; and

WHEREAS, the mission of Roots of Peace is to identify existing challenges in war-torn regions through engagement with local farmers and community members, design intervention aimed at improving safety, quality and production of agricultural lands, increase crop exports to support economic vitality, and generate peace and prosperity through economic independence; and

WHEREAS, as Chief Executive Officer, Heidi generated initial support from famed Napa Valley vintners including Robert Mondavi, Miljenko "Mike" Grgich, and Diane Disney Miller, to replace fields ravaged by landmines with vineyards and other agricultural crops; and

WHEREAS, Roots of Peace has been recognized for its humanitarian efforts by the United States Government, the United Nations, World Bank, and Rotary International. Heidi and her dedication have been recognized by numerous world leaders including UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan and UN Chef de Cabinet E. Courtenay Rattray, His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI, His Holiness Pope Francis, His Holiness the Dalai Lama, and many heads of state and government officials; and

WHEREAS, Heidi published her book, "Breaking Ground" in April 2020, which is both a memoir and a call to action in her quest to eradicate landmines and plant the roots of peace worldwide; and

WHEREAS, this year, Roots of Peace celebrates its 25th anniversary of cultivating peace through agriculture and cultural partnerships. The organization has impacted more than 1 million farmers and families across eight countries, and has helped generate over \$1 billion in agricultural production in those nations; and

WHEREAS, as part of the September 8 launch of World Affairs Napa Valley, a new chapter of the global affairs organization that was founded in the United States in 1947, Heidi Kuhn will give the keynote address on behalf of Roots of Peace and its global humanitarian effort.

Dear Ms. Kühn,

On the occasion of the 25th anniversary of Roots of Peace Mines to Vines initiative, I would like to congratulate you on your significant achievements and thank you for your partnership with USAID in Afghanistan over the years.

Our partnership began in 2003 when decades of war left Afghanistan's farming infrastructure in ruins and market linkages broken. With millions of farmers in search of income, USAID projects implemented by Roots of Peace provided inputs aimed at jump-starting the agricultural economy through seed and fertilizer distributions and projects focused on keeping youth from joining the insurgency. We also partnered on rebuilding roads and irrigation systems.

Later, USAID began an approach aimed at sustainable economic growth, with Roots of Peace as an important partner. We began working together with Afghan grape farmers on varieties that were in high commercial demand. Our trellising technology resulted in a 100-200 percent increase in yields. The transformation in yield and quality of grapes propelled by Roots of Peace became an example for others to emulate, and today, it has become the mainstay of grape cultivation in Afghanistan. Moreover, Roots of Peace has planted five million fruit trees in Afghanistan. You also established the first export cold chain in the country and oversaw the first refrigerated exports: fresh apricots to Karachi, grapes to Delhi, and eventually fresh fruit exports to 11 other countries.

Today, we celebrate the partnership between USAID and Roots of Peace that has assisted Afghan farmers to shift from cultivating lower-value annual crops such as wheat to higher-value perennial crops, such as apples, apricots, almonds, pomegranates, and grapes.

We wish you a great celebration on September 8, 2022, and continued success in years to come.



Dear Mrs. Kuhn,

On behalf of my Afghan woman-owned company, Benazir Yakta, Ltd., I would like to personally congratulate you on the 25th Anniversary of Roots of Peace—the vision of an American mother to transform minefields into thriving farmland worldwide.

I am the personal beneficiary of your vision to turn MINES TO VINES, as Afghanistan is the most heavily mined countries in the world. Yet, you have set your sites on cultivating peace through agriculture, as you have healed the wounds of war. My company exists as a result of your investment in peace, as USAID/CHAMP funded my business in 2017.

As a result of this program implemented by Roots of Peace, I was able to build my business from Kabul, to employ over 80 Afghan women to export fresh and dried fruits to international markets. Working with multiple provinces in Afghanistan, we provide pre-harvest and post-harvest programs to improve the value chain and increase income.

Agriculture is the basement of all nations. And, Heidi Kuhn, Founder, Roots of Peace worked diligently from the basement of her own home in California to bring this vision across the world to impact Afghan men and women. Our country is 80% dependent upon agriculture for jobs, and Mrs. Kuhn and her staff planted over six million fruit trees for sustainable peace through agriculture to thrive.

I would personally like to extend my most sincere gratitude to Mrs. Kuhn who mentored me as a young Afghan business woman. One year ago, when the U.S. military withdrawal occurred on August 31, 2021, she worked hard as a mother to evacuate her staff who were most at risk. As a Hazara woman, and business leader, my life was highly at risk.

Mrs. Kuhn wrote a personal letter to President Joseph Biden and Speaker Nancy Pelosi to assure that I was safely evacuated as a pregnant mother whose life was threatened.

She flew to Washington, D.C., and personally appealed to the U.S. Ambassador of Pakistan to secure a VISA to save my life. As a result, my husband and I were able to travel along a dangerous pass through the Torkham border and safely arrived in Islamabad—to deliver my first-born son, Amir, via emergency cesarian (C-Section) in the hospital.

The life of my son—and myself—were saved through her tireless efforts to assure our safe evacuation and delivery of life.

I remain most grateful to Roots of Peace for their continued efforts to plant over one million fruit trees in my beloved country in Afghanistan during the Spring of 2022.

Our hearts remain in our country, and we remain hopeful that Mrs. Kuhn may fulfill her dream to plant the Roots of Peace on former war-torn lands worldwide—for the sake of our families left behind who face staggering hunger and starvation in the months ahead.



As an Emmy-award winning journalist and former ABC7 News Anchor, I have traveled with Heidi and Gary Kuhn for nearly 20 years to document and validate the work of Roots of Peace in several war-torn countries. My first trip to Afghanistan was in 2005 to observe the Roots of Peace pilot program. I went back to Afghanistan in 2015 with Heidi and Gary to see what progress had been made, and it was stunning.

Roots of Peace introduced modern farming methods and refrigeration storage to Afghanistan for the first time, and provided training in sorting, packing, and marketing. They linked farmers with traders and international markets. This non-profit's work with its funding partners raised the gross domestic product in Afghanistan by more than two per cent. Under Heidi and Gary's leadership, Roots of Peace increased agricultural exports from \$250 million in 2014 to more than \$1.4 billion in 2020. The funding came from the U.S. Agency for International Development's CHAMP Program: Commercial Horticulture and Agricultural Marketing Program. That's a nation-changing success! Thank you, Roots of Peace for your passion and commitment!
